Suburban Legal Assistance Clinics

The Center for Disability & Elder Law (CDEL) offers four monthly Suburban Legal Assistance Clinics (SLACs) at senior centers in suburban Cook County. At the SLACs, seniors are able to meet one on one with an attorney who can provide eligible seniors with legal assistance.

If you are interested in making an appointment please follow the following steps:

1. **Call (312) 376-1880 ext. 22** and leave a message with your name and phone number
2. A CDEL volunteer will call you back to gather basic information about you and your legal issue
3. If we may be able to help you, we will give you an appointment to meet with an attorney so that we can learn more about your case
4. If we cannot assist you, we will provide you with an appropriate referral
